


SUGARBUSH PRESERVE SITE MAP

The large trees form a high canopy giving the forest floor below an open character. The moist soils create ideal conditions for an unusual variety of wildflowers and ferns that grow in the shady understory. The soils also help promote fast growth of sugar maple trees, many of which have been tapped for maple syrup for centuries. Many kinds of birds and other animals use the forest, making it a retreat not only for people but for wildlife.


Sugarbush Preserve is a nature preserve, please be respectful during your visit.




