GENERAL ELECTION—NOVEMBER 4, 2014



WHERE TO VOTE (MAP ON FOLLOWING PAGE):

Precinct 1, Livonia Residents who live on the **WEST** side of US Hwy 169 and **East** of **County Rd 1** vote at the Fresh Waters Church located at 12475 273rd Ave near the intersection of 273rd Ave and US Hwy 169. Directions from the stop light at County Rd 4 and County Rd 45: go North on County Rd 45 to 273rd Ave (1 1/2 miles). Go East (right) on 273rd Ave (1/2 mile) to Church entrance on the right. Directions from the stop light at Hwy 169 and County Rd 4: go North on Hwy 169 to 273rd Ave (1 1/2 miles). Go West (left) on 273rd Ave and turn South (left) into Church entrance.

Precinct 2, Livonia Residents who live on the **EAST** side of US Hwy 169 vote in the Town Hall Building located at 11162 265th Ave. Directions from the stop light at Hwy 169 and County Rd 4: go East on County Rd 4 to County Rd 39 (1 1/2 miles). Go North (left) on County Rd 39 (1/2 mile) to 265th Ave. Go East (right) on 265th Ave to Town Hall entrance.


Precinct 3, Livonia Residents who live on the **West** side of **County Rd 1** vote at the Fresh Waters Church located at 12475 273rd Ave near the intersection of 273rd Ave and US Hwy 169. Directions from the stop light at County Rd 4 and County Rd 45: go North on County Rd 45 to 273rd Ave (1 1/2 miles). Go East (right) on 273rd Ave (1/2 mile) to Church entrance on the right. Directions from the stop light at Hwy 169 and County Rd 4: go North on Hwy 169 to 273rd Ave (1 1/2 miles). Go West (left) on 273rd Ave and turn South (left) into Church entrance.

POLLS OPEN: Polls open at **7:00 am** and close at **8:00 pm**. Voters waiting in line at closing time are allowed to register/vote. Those who arrive after the closing hour are not allowed to vote.

VOTER ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible to vote, a person must be 18 years of age or older the day of the election, a US citizen, and have maintained residence in MN for 20 days preceding the election.

YOU NEED TO REGISTER IF: You have moved, changed your name, just became eligible to vote, or have not voted in the last four years. Voter registration applications are available at the Township or County Offices. You can register on Election Day with the proper identification and proof of residency. To save time at the poll, you can register now.

SHERBURNE COUNTY YARD WASTE COMPOST SITE

Residents can recycle yard waste, leaves and branches up to 9" in diameter at the Zimmerman compost site. Access is behind Nelson Nursery at Main St and 2nd Ave., 1/2 mile down the gravel road. An access card (free of charge) is required.

You can obtain your card at Zimmerman City Hall during their regular hours. Wood chips and finished compost are available first come first serve. Please do not dispose of yard waste in Township ditches.



What do I do with...???


Do you have **unwanted medicines** that you don't know what to do with? Sherburne County Residents can drop them off in the drop box located inside the Sheriffs office at the Gov't Center. Leave in original container, remove patient's name with a black marker

Do you have **Household Hazardous Waste** and you don't know what to do with it? Bring it to a Sherburne County Household Hazardous Waste Collection event. Contact Sherburne County Zoning (763-765-4466) for locations and details.

Have you been to **Sugarbush Park**? This beautiful Township gem is lush with plants and teeming with birds! The park is approximately 40 acres with two trails. The inner loop is a hard-packed 6 foot wide gravel path and the outer loop is a 3 foot wide dirt path. While there look for the huge Sugar Maple and Basswood trees, the understory of ferns, small wetlands, warblers and other birds and wildlife. The park is located at the end of the cul-de-sac on 232nd Ave (off 239th Ave) in the southwest corner of Livonia Township. No motorized vehicles are allowed in the park.

2014 ROAD PROJECTS

- Crack Sealant repair on 10 miles of roads completed in early June.
- Second lift of bituminous and final shouldering of 112th St 2 miles north of 269th to 285th Ave. This project is again partnered with Baldwin Township to save on costs
- Reconstruction/Reclamation of 1/2 mile of 273rd Ave west of HWY 169 to County Road 45.
- Second lift of bituminous on 120th St From Hickory St to just past the entrance to Grams Park.
- Reconstruction of 1000' of 239th Ave at Tibbits Brook including a new culvert.
- Aggregate Chip Sealant placed on about 3 miles of roads located in the developments of Country Meadows, Prairie Hills, Hobby Acres, Windsor Farms, Savannah Station, and Swanson Illusive Meadow. Liquid asphalt and then aggregate rocks are put down and the excess is swept up after a short curing process.
- Ditch mowing, tree trimming, pot hole patch, and shoulder repair are being done as needed throughout the summer.
