



Workshop Meeting of the Livonia Town Board  
Held at the Livonia Town Hall  
Friday, April 12, 2019

Supervisors present: Hass, Hiller, Kuker, Maloney and Pool

Staff present: Clerk/Treasurer Hammre,

The Workshop Meeting came to order at 10:00 am. for the purpose of discussing: parks; new laws pertaining to weight limit signage and enforcement; the current Annexation Agreement with the City of Zimmerman.

Park topics discussed included signage, parking lot and priorities for the Park Board. Hiller reiterated that the role of the Park Board is to recommend actions to the Town Board, the Town Board then makes final decisions. Website updates and posts were also discussed. Kuker stated that he has a machine that will prepare the roughed in trail for the application of surface material. Hiller/Hass unanimous to allow Kuker to work on the roughed-in trails at North Point Park and Sugarbush Park with Livonia Maintenance when time permits. Maloney stated that he will follow through on a quote for a wood name sign for North Point Park in the same style as the current Sugarbush Preserve sign. A North Point Park Dedication was suggested for June. Playground equipment maintenance was discussed with the suggestion that the Livonia Maintenance Coordinator could attend training and be certified to inspect the equipment to satisfy safety standards. No action taken. Picnic table options mentioned included 7' concrete picnic tables at around \$400 plus shipping from a source in St Joseph.

Weight limit signage was discussed. Hass explained that the Sherburne County Sheriff's Office contacted the Township about the recent law change that requires specific signage at the entrance of any lower weight limit road from a higher weight limit road. Lack of signage prevents the ability of overweight vehicles to be ticketed and can result in substantial road damage. Maintenance to tally the number of signs needed.

Also discussed were the requests for overweight vehicle permits. Hass suggested that the Township charge a fee for overweight vehicle permits. Further research and consultation with Township Engineer Anderson needed.

The Annexation Agreement was discussed with the current Annexation Agreement with the City of Zimmerman due to expire soon.

The Workshop meeting concluded at 11:03 am.
